



# Let's make a PIÑATA

Check out our **tutorial** first. It gives you an overview on how this DIY project can go. Are you having doubts on how to proceed or you just glued your hands together? No problem, just check out our **step-by-step plan**. Remember, DIY'ing and crafting is a lot of messing around and trying and failing. If it doesn't go as planned or if it's hard, you are doing it right.

**Step 1:** Blow up the balloon, as big as you want. Try it, it can get really really big.

**Step 2:** Wrap the balloon in old newspapers and paper tape, like you would wrap a present. Don't stick the tape or paper to the balloon!

**Step 3:** Cut thousands of paper strips from a newspaper. Grab a plate and fill it with glue. Take a paper strip, add glue to it and start sticking it onto the paper wrapped balloon.

Keep on doing this until the balloon is completely covered. Let it dry. And do it all over again. The more layers you give the balloon, the stronger the piñata will get. Let it dry before you continue. When it's dry, take a knife or scissors and cut open the balloon, so you can take it out. When the balloon is out, the candy goes in.

**Step 4:** When all layers are done, take the paper cups. Glue the cups onto the piñata. Glue two cups with the open side outwards, these two will become the eyes.

**Step 5:** You can use adhesive tape or the paper tape to make sure the paper cups stay in place.

**Step 6:** Take the green frizzle paper. Glue short pieces onto the piñata and keep on doing it until it's completely covered. Don't forget the cups!

**Step 7:** Take two white balloons and blow them up just a little bit. These are the two eyeballs. Draw an eye on each balloon and stick them in the eye sockets (cups).

**Step 8:** Hang the piñata, grab a stick, hit it and tadaaa! Enjoy! Candy!!!
