




MARBLE MANIAC BOX

In this **Joybox** you can find instructions and all the craft supplies you need to make a **marble run**. But it gets even more fun when you let your imagination run wild! Expand your track with toilet paper rolls, bowls, pool noodles and anything else you can find around the house!



Tornado Twister: Take a paper towel roll or tape several toilet paper rolls together to create one long paper roll. Cut a hole in the middle of each paper plate that has the same diameter as the long paper roll. Then cut a straight line from the centre to the outside of the plate.

Stick the roll upright on a large piece of cardboard. Slide the plates over the roll. Tape them together to form a spiral around the roll. Take the cut part of the paper plate and tape it to the cut part of the plate underneath. Tape the top and bottom plates to the top and bottom of the roll.




Downhill Dropper: Grab an old cereal or shoe box and cut out one of the sides. Then cut several toilet paper rolls in half and glue them in a zigzag manner in the box.

Create an opening at the bottom of the box so that the marbles can roll out.

Hypno Funnel: Cut a 2 centimetre hole in the centre of a paper plate. Cut a long strip of cardboard and tape it along the edge of the plate to create a border. Cut an opening of 5 centimetres in the border.

Cut a toilet paper roll or kitchen paper roll in half along the length and tape it diagonally into the opening.






MARBLE MANIAC BOX

Is everything alright with your marble track so far?
Great, let's move on then!

Mad Maze: Open the box for your Joybox and cut away the upright edges so only a long piece of cardboard remains. You can reinforce the sides with tape and scraps of cardboard to keep the long piece of cardboard straight.

Place the cups in a row and glue them to the bottom of the cardboard. Now you can glue all the lollipop sticks randomly to the cardboard on their sides. Make the maze as hard as you want!



The Highest Gear: Tape together LOTS of toilet paper rolls, paper towel rolls, tubes, or whatever you can find around the house to create one continuous lane.

You can install them against your door, place them carefully against the wall, or put them down the stairs. Just make sure the track always slopes a little downwards.

What's next? Make your track as long and as crazy as you want! Maybe you could try a vertical loop? Connect all the elements together and finish your marble track in a nice colour using the paint! **On your marks, get set, GO!**
